GIRLS DRESS CODE GRADES 7-12

1. Pants

- 1.1. Jeans/slacks must not be too tight. If skinny or slim-fit pants are worn, shirt must come down at least to the fingertips all the way around; loose-fitting dress pants/jeans do not require longer shirts
- 1.2. No frayed hems, tears, rips, or holes in pants/jeans
- 1.3. No shorts (except during P.E., athletics, field day)
- 1.4. No leggings, except with dresses
- 1.5 No writing on pants/jeans
- 1.6 No yoga pants with or without flare
- 1.7 No joggers.

2. Shirts and blouses

- 2.1. Necklines no lower than 3 inches below collarbone
- 2.2. Sheer blouses must have dress code shirts underneath
- 2.3. Sleeveless shoulders at least 3 inches wide
- 2.4. Undergarments must not be visible
- 2.5. No t-shirts (the type that might have writing on them)
- 2.6. TCS or Christian/church t-shirts (non-collared) may be worn on Fridays

3. Skirts and dresses

- 3.1. No shorter than the top of the knee (which is 3 inches above the knee when kneeling) 3.2. Slits no shorter than the top of the knee
- 4. No flip-flops or flip-flop type shoes

5. Outerwear

- 5.1. No heavy coats or jackets in the classroom
- 5.2. Sweaters and light zip-up jackets allowed
- 5.3. Sweatshirts, hoodies and pullovers allowed
 - 5.3.1. Must be TCS or plain (however a *small pocket-sized* brand-name logo or monogrammed initials are allowed)
 - 5.3.2. May not have any other writing, pictures or drawings

6. No tattoos

- 7. No piercings, except for ears; no plugs with gauged earlobes
- 8. Hair no unnatural colors

STUDENT ATTIRE AT BALLGAMES, CASUAL EVENTS, ETC.

- 1. Jeans and knee-length shorts may be worn
- 2. T-shirts may be worn (no questionable wording or pictures)
- 3. Students should consider what is modest and appropriate

BOYS DRESS CODE GRADES 7-12

1. Pants

- 1.1. Solid color slacks or jeans (pants must be nice and clean)
- 1.2. No rips, holes, tears, frays in jeans/slacks, no frayed hems or writing on pants
- 1.3. No military-style or camouflage pants
- 1.4. Tucking in shirts is optional, no sagging
- 1.5. No shorts (except during P.E., athletics, field day)

2. Shirts

- 2.1. Must have collars
- 2.2. Must not have writing or pictures, except brand name logos
- 2.3. Crew neck sweaters do not require collared shirts underneath
- 2.4. TCS or Christian/church t-shirts (non-collared) may be worn on Fridays

3. Shoes

3.1. No flip-flops or sandals

4. Outerwear

- 4.1. No heavy coats or jackets in the classroom
- 4.2. Sweaters and light zip-up jackets allowed
- 4.3. Sweatshirts, hoodies and pullovers allowed
 - 4.3.1. Must be worn with tucked in collared shirt
 - 4.3.2. Must be TCS or plain (however a *small pocket-sized* brand-name logo is allowed)
 - 4.3.3 May not have any other writing, pictures or drawings

5. No jewelry, tattoos, or piercings

6. Hair

- 6.1. Not over collar or ears
- 6.2. May not touch eyebrows
- 6.3. May not flip out or be tucked behind ears
- 6.5. No sideburns past bottom of ear
- 6.6. Must be a natural color

7. Face must be clean shaven
